

**Chattanooga Region SCCA

This event is held under SCCA 2007 General Competition Rules (GCR), Category Specifications and FasTrack amendments, and the SCCA Club Racing Practice Day Requirements.

This Practice Day is before the September 1 & 2 Double SARRC sanction by the Atlanta Region and is primarily for entrants in that event but cars and drivers not entered in that event are eligible to run the Practice Day, if they meet eligibility requirements.

1. **Entry Forms and Fees:** Registration for this event can be accessed via links on the Atlanta Region Home Page (www.Atl-SCCA.org). If you have not previously registered for an event via the DLBRacing.com Online Registration System, you will be prompted to create an account before you can register.

A second driver will be allowed in a registered car for a fee of \$25.00. Registration at the track will also be accepted, but no Credit Cards will be accepted there. See schedule for times of Registration. Registration at Nashville Superspeedway will be at the Ticket Booth under the "Will Call" sign.

2. **Credentials & Passes:** The entry fee entitles the entrant to (5) passes, including driver and entrant. Only SCCA members will be issued crew passes. Non-members will receive visitor passes and may not enter hazardous areas. Members and non-members must wear their passes visible at all times.
3. **Car Eligibility:** All cars are eligible that meet the Safety Specifications of the SCCA GCR & Category Specifications. Entrant of each car will be required to certify by his signature that the entered car meets these safety requirements. Cars may be those listed as Regional or National Racing Class, Southeast Divisional Classes and Atlanta Regional Classes. Cars prepared to other organizations may also enter so long as they meet SCCA Safety Specifications.
4. **Drivers:** Eligible Drivers are current SCCA members with a National or Regional License. In addition drivers with a Novice Permit who have successfully completed all Drivers School requirements are eligible.
5. **Operations:** Practice Day cars will be split into at least three groups for on-track sessions. A maximum of 35 cars will be allowed in each group.
6. **Drivers Meeting:** Drivers meeting will be in written form and be handed out at Registration.
7. **Flags:** Signaling will be done by flags and by lights. Black Flag Station will be Station 3. Black Flags will be displayed at Station 3 and Start/Finish. The Checkered Flag will also be displayed at Station 3 and Start/Finish to end sessions.

8. **Contact:** Car to Car contact must be avoided per the GCR. All cars involved in contact will be Black Flagged. Drivers involved in flagrant violation of the contact rules will be disqualified.
9. **Restricted Radio Frequencies:** Nashville Superspeedway radio frequencies are 452.400, 457.400, 461.400, 463.300, 466.400, 468.300. Do not use these for your communications.
10. **Emergency Lanes:** Keep all lanes in the paddock open at all times. This is necessary so that emergency vehicles of all sorts can fulfill their duties. If you leave a vehicle blocking an emergency lane, it will be removed without warning.
11. **Property Damage:** Nashville Superspeedway and/or SCCA-Chattanooga Region may hold drivers responsible for damages to property. Drivers continually cutting apexes in the grass may be held financially responsible for repairs and may be penalized.
12. **Garage Rental:** Chattanooga Region will charge a fee of \$20 for use of a Garage space at Nashville SuperSpeedway during the Practice Day on Friday, August 31 and Thursday night to benefit workers at the event. One hundred percent of the funds raised from Garage Rental will go to workers at the Practice Day in the form of a lunch plus a cash expense reimbursement. Any funds left after paying for the lunch will be disbursed in cash to workers at the end of the event on Friday afternoon in equal shares. Competitors will be invited to contribute into this fund in excess of the minimum \$20 should they wish to do so.
13. **Medical:** If you are sick or injured, please check with the Medical Staff at the Ambulance. They will treat you as needed and assist in necessary paperwork.
14. **Camping:** Camping at the track is allowed Thursday night in a Recreational Vehicle, Vehicle or Trailer only – No Tent Camping is allowed by local regulations. Use of the Camping Area is no charge. It includes electricity (50 amp only – standard #14-50 receptacles). Water and Cable TV is furnished at each site.
